Lottery requests must be submitted via e-mail at Raymond.E.Rainbolt.civ@mail.mil by 6:00 am on Thursday morning to hunt the following Tuesday, Thursday, and/or Saturday.

Submit the following:

- Your name & permit #
- Date(s) you wish to hunt
- Blind you wish to hunt from
- Name & Permit # of up to three other hunters that will hunt with you.

The lottery is open to anyone that can access Fort Drum; however, there are three levels of preference:

* First preference are hunters with accessibility needs which include: hunters possessing a New York State Non-Ambulatory Hunter Permit; hunters with severe permanent disabilities eligible for a New York State Parking Permit or License Plate; or hunters with a life-threatening illness participating through a non-profit organization.

* Second preference are Soldiers currently assigned to a Warrior in Transition Unit or disabled hunters with a 100% Rating Decision in a VA Award Letter.

* If no hunters apply in the first two preference levels, then the lottery is conducted with all other applicants.
