

Recreational User: Accessing Account to Check-in for Recreation via Computer or Smart Phone

1. Go to the web page: <https://FortDrum.iSportsman.net>

2. Check which areas are open. This can be down in three ways.

2A. First, you can see the areas listed and their status as “Closed” in a red box or “Open” in a green box. Scroll down the list to check the status of all the areas. To see the list, go to the navigation bar and click on “Maps” and click on “Area Status” on the dropdown menu.

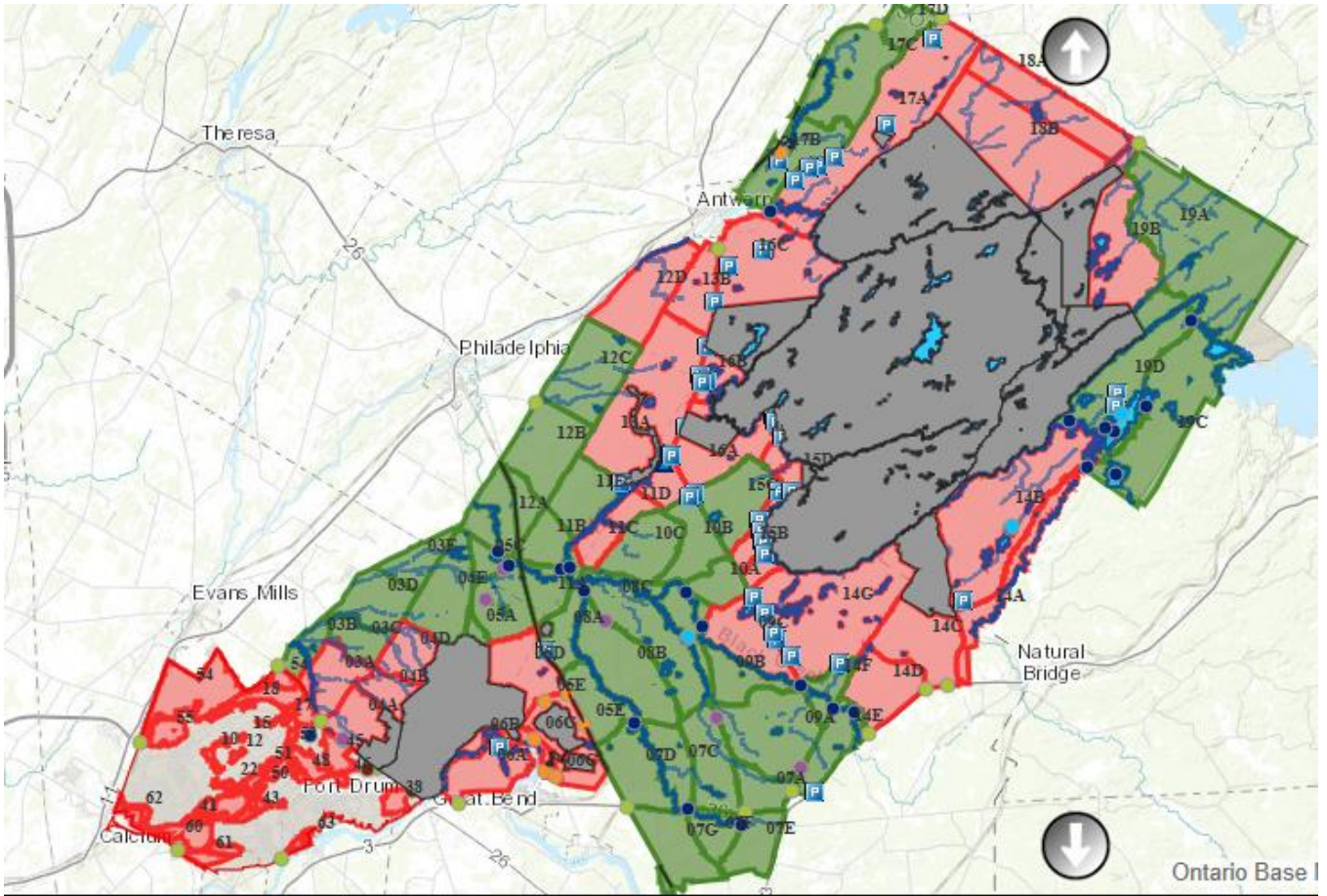

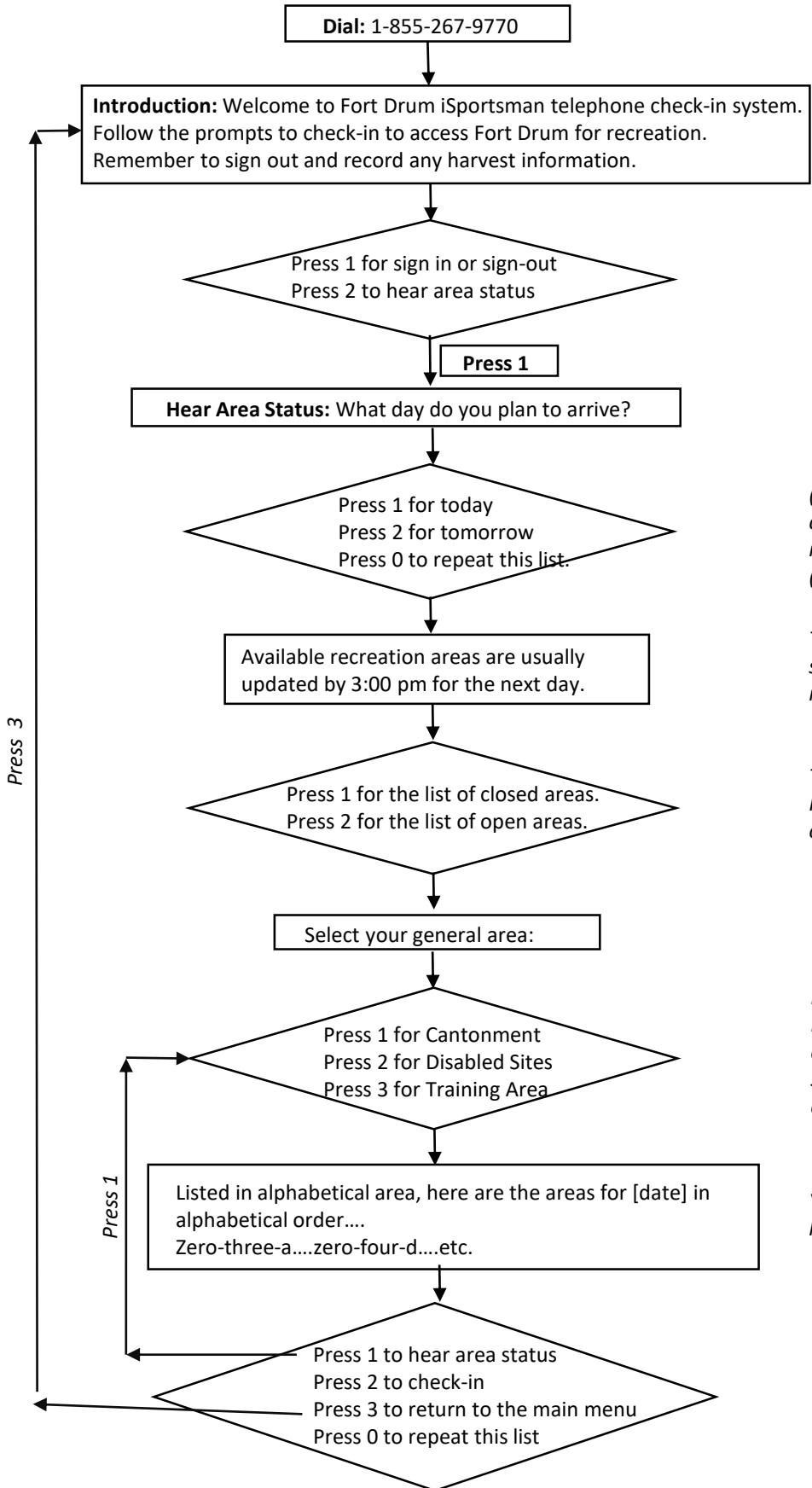

2B. Second, you can see the areas on an interactive map. Go to the navigation bar and click on "Maps" and click on "Interactive Map" on the dropdown menu.. The areas that are open are shown in green and the closed areas are shown in red.



2C. Third, you can hear which areas are open by calling the new Sportsman's Hotline.



(Based on the time you are calling...press 1 for today (before midnight) or press 2 for tomorrow (after midnight)).

The phone and computer system should be updated by 3:00 pm for the next day.

To hear areas open for recreation, Press 2 will be the most common option to select.

Because the Cantonment Area and Disabled Sites are either restricted access and/or are typically a set schedule, Press 3 will be the most common option to select.

You have to listen to the entire list or hang up and call back to sign in.



4. Enter your “Login Id” (1) and your “Password” (2) and click the “Login” button (3).
